Dual Enrollment Program

The Dual Enrollment Program fosters partnerships between UW Colleges campuses and regional high schools in an effort to enhance the educational opportunities for students. Through these partnerships, students at some area high schools can enroll for both high school and college credit when they take certain classes taught by University of Wisconsin Colleges faculty.

High School Responsibilities

- Sign the Memorandum of Understanding and return to UW Colleges prior to:
 - Fall Semester: **April 15**
 - Spring Semester: **September 15**
- Schedule Placement Tests if needed (English, Math & World Languages)
- Submit high school transcripts
- Submit class roster(s) for each class

Students will be enrolled based on admissions, prerequisites and the submitted class rosters.

Deadlines

- All documents and applications must be received by:
- Fall Semester: **August 10**
 - Spring Semester: **January 1**
