

# Applicant Checklist

Thank you for your interest in a UW Colleges campus! The following information will help keep you on track through the admission and financial aid process.

## 1. Apply!

- Complete the online University of Wisconsin System application at [apply.wisconsin.edu](http://apply.wisconsin.edu). If you have questions during the completion of your application, view the Ask Tyler videos at [apply.wisconsin.edu/help/Videos.aspx](http://apply.wisconsin.edu/help/Videos.aspx) or contact UW Colleges at 888-463-6892 or [uwcsolutioncenter@uwc.edu](mailto:uwcsolutioncenter@uwc.edu).
- There is a \$50 application fee at the completion of your online application. You may pay the fee with a credit card when you electronically submit your application or pay by check, payable to UW Colleges and send it to **UW Colleges Admissions, 780 Regent Street, Madison, WI 53715**.
- Submit an official copy of your high school transcript and any college transcripts if you took college credit in high school. Contact your high school to request an official transcript to be sent to UW Colleges Admissions (address listed above). If you have obtained a GED or HSED, you must submit a copy of your diploma or test scores.
- Have your **ACT or SAT scores** mailed to **UW Colleges Admissions, 780 Regent Street, Madison, WI 53715** or have a copy of your scores be included with your high school transcript.

**Please note, your application is not complete until the following are received: Online application, application fee, official transcript(s), a copy of ACT or SAT scores.**

## 2. Research Financial Aid Options

- All students are encouraged to apply for financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov) using our code: 003897. Please be aware that your financial aid award letter and any financial aid communication will occur by your campus email account. It's important once you are admitted to UW Colleges that you set up your college email and check it at a minimum of once per week.

## 3. Apply for Scholarships

- Apply for scholarships at your high school and from your college(s) of acceptance. Watch your email and pay attention to application deadlines!

## 4. Register for Placement Testing and Advising & Registration Days

- Watch your personal email for information on how to register for your Placement Tests and Advising & Registration Days.
