Eligibility Requirements

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

- ✓ If you have not already done so, complete the **2018-2019** FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov by June 30, 2019.

UW Colleges school code **003897** (for 2018-2019 only)

- ✓ If you have not already done so, include or add school code 003897 to your **2018-2019** FAFSA.

Degree-seeking status

- ✓ You must be admitted at the campus where you are enrolled for summer as a **degree-seeking** student.
- ✓ Special students and other non-degree seeking students are not eligible for federal student financial aid.

Check your UW Colleges **student email account** and **PRISM**

- ✓ All communications related to your summer 2019 aid will be emailed to your UW Colleges student email account.
- ✓ Monitor your email for requests for additional information or documentation. You will not be awarded aid until all required documents have been received and processed by the Student Financial Aid Office.

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)

- ✓ You must meet SAP standards or successfully appeal your SAP standing with your campus by the deadline.
- ✓ Approved SAP appeals must be received by the Student Financial Aid Office before your summer session ends.

Late applicants are not guaranteed aid. Complete all of the above no later than June 30, 2019.

SUMMER 2019 FINANCIAL AID SUMMARY

Eligibility for Summer Financial Aid

Eligibility is based on your:

- Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as calculated via the FAFSA
- Cost of Attendance
- Enrollment status

<i>Less than half-time (1 to 5 credits)</i>	<i>Half-time (6 to 8 credits)</i>
<i>Three quarter-time (9 to 11 course credits)</i>	<i>Full-time (12 or more course credits)</i>
- Remaining eligibility from 2018-2019 award year for summer Pell Grant and/or Direct Loans
- Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standing

Satisfactory Academic Progress is assessed at the end of the spring 2019 semester. If you are not meeting SAP standards, you may appeal to regain financial aid eligibility. Contact your campus for information on how to appeal. **To receive summer aid, you must successfully appeal, and formal notification of your approved appeal must be received by the Student Financial Aid Office from your campus, before your summer enrollment ends.**

Types of Summer Financial Aid

Federal Pell Grant

- If enrolled in **fewer than 6 credits**, you must have remaining eligibility from your annual 2018-2019 Pell Grant award to be awarded a summer Pell Grant.
- If enrolled in **6 or more credits**, you may be eligible for an Additional Pell Grant.

- Students receiving Pell Grant funds **must attend and academically participate in all courses** for which the Pell Grant was awarded. **Dropping a class before it begins, or failing to initiate class participation, may result in a recalculation and even complete cancellation** of your Pell Grant.
- Students receiving Additional Pell Grant funds **must initiate academic participation in a minimum of 6 credits. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of the entire Additional Pell Grant.**
- Changes in Pell Grant awards may result in a **balance due on your student account.**

Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Student Loans (6 credits or higher enrollment required)

- You must have remaining eligibility from the 2018-2019 annual loan limits:

Freshman Dependent: \$5,500	Sophomore Dependent: \$6,500	BAAS Dependent: \$7,500
Freshman Independent: \$9,500	Sophomore Independent: \$10,500	BAAS Independent: \$12,500

Direct Parent PLUS Loan (6 credits or higher enrollment required)

- You must be a dependent student as defined by the FAFSA. Your parent is the borrower and repays the loan.
- Maximum Direct Parent PLUS eligibility is summer Cost of Attendance minus all other aid.

Enrollment Changes and Impact on Summer Financial Aid

- Class drops and failure to initiate and academically participate in classes may result in changes to your summer financial aid, even if you have already received a refund check.
- Withdrawal from all classes before completing 60 percent of your scheduled enrollment period will result in calculation of aid earned and aid unearned. **Students must repay all reduced, cancelled, and/or unearned financial aid.**

Disbursement Schedule

- When all eligibility requirements are met, funds disburse the first Wednesday of a student's summer enrollment.
- Most financial aid is credited directly toward your University of Wisconsin Colleges student account.
- If there are aid funds remaining after applicable UW Colleges institutional charges are paid, a refund check in the amount of the remaining funds is mailed to you. **Keep your home/ mailing address in PRISM current** to avoid delays in receiving your refund check.
- Refund checks generated from Parent PLUS loans are mailed to the parent borrower.
