

## Winterim 2019 Financial Aid Information and Application

- For financial aid purposes, winterim 2019 enrollment is considered part of the spring 2019 semester. However, winterim tuition and fees are separate from spring semester charges, and have earlier due dates.
  - The combined winterim and spring semester credits will determine your aid eligibility for the spring term.
  - You must complete the winterim credits for them to be included as part of your spring semester aid eligibility.
- **Aid for winterim credits will not be disbursed until the initial spring semester financial aid disbursement on February 11.**
- Submit this application after having registered for winterim 2019 class(es) in PRISM. **Submission is necessary for:**
  - Aid applicants who will not be enrolled for at least six credits for the spring semester and wish to receive a Direct Loan(s) for spring based on the combined credits of winterim and the spring term.
  - Those who will be enrolled for 12 or more credits for spring and wish to have an adjustment to the spring cost of attendance (used in determining maximum aid eligibility for spring) to reflect the charges for winterim.
- *For all others, submission of the application is optional (this document is for informational purposes).*

### Aid eligibility issues:

If you are enrolled for winterim and have completed the FAFSA application, your completed winterim credits will be counted towards your spring Federal Pell Grant, if you are eligible to receive Pell. If you plan on attending a different school for the spring semester, note you may receive a Pell Grant from only one institution for the spring 2019 semester.

To be eligible for Federal Direct (Subsidized/Unsubsidized/Parent PLUS) Loans or Federal Work-Study, your combined credit load must be at least six credits. ***If you already have been awarded the maximum annual Direct Student Loan for your grade level and financial aid dependency status, winterim credits will not increase your Direct Student Loan awards::***

Combined Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Student Loan annual limits:

### To establish aid eligibility for winterim 2019:

1. release at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) your 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) using FAFSA school code 003897 and provide supporting documents (such as Verification documents, if requested) to UW Colleges.
2. complete the above by January 15, 2019.
3. be admitted as a degree-seeking student and meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress standards at UW Colleges.
