- An academic transcript that indicates you successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree
- Homeschooled Students (follow the law in your state of legal residence):
  - If State law requires a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), attach a copy of that credential.
  - If State law does not require a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), attach a transcript or the equivalent, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and includes a statement of the student's successful completion of a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.
    - *Note:* the State of Wisconsin does not require a secondary school completion credential for homeschooling.

If you are unable to obtain the documentation listed above, you must contact the Student Financial Aid Office.
